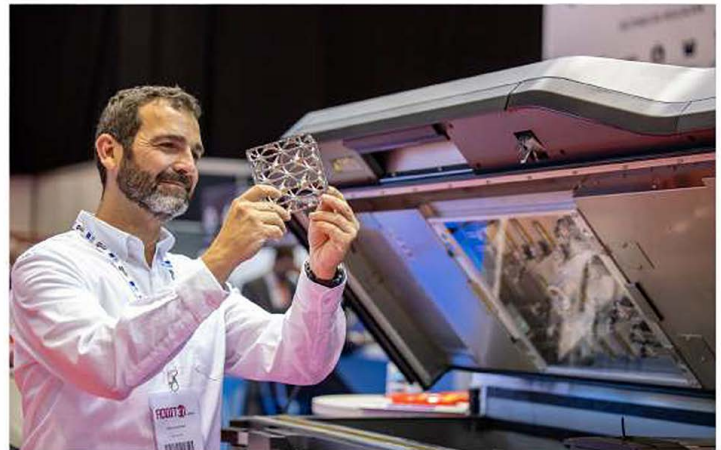

## UNDER THE FRAMEWORK OF BIEMH, A BENCHMARK INTERNATIONAL EVENT FOR INDUSTRY

The fifth ADDIT3D trade fair is to be held concurrently with the **31st BIEMH**, Spain's biggest international machine-tool and advanced manufacturing event. The previous BIEMH featured 1751 exhibiting firms from 21 countries and 42,445 visitors from 61 countries.

Addit3D is scheduled to take place in Hall 4.0, which it will be sharing with the BeDigital trade fair on the industrial application of digital technologies, and with the IMIC (Industrial Innovation Maintenance Conference).
